- Health papers will be checked, current rabies vaccination and Coggins Test required (as appropriate for species).
- Contestants compete at their own risk.
- The use of alcoholic beverages on the Fairgrounds will result in disqualification and removal from the Fairgrounds.
- Good sportsmanship and conduct is expected. All pullers are required to sign the 4-H Code of Conduct to participate.
- Any poor sportsmanship or inappropriate actions will be grounds for disqualification. This includes vulgar or foul language.
- Weight is recorded from the last show entered for Horse and Ox.

All non-4-H (including adults) entries are required to sign the 4-H Code of Conduct to participate.
