Exhibitors must include proof of rabies vaccination and 4-H animal project verification forms for all dogs with entry form. Late entries will be considered at the discretion of the Superintendent!

- Day of Show: Check-in starts at 8:00. Judging will begin at 9:00.
- Open to all youth enrolled in the Connecticut 4-H program. Bring your 4-H animal project verification forms.
- Dress code for 4-H dog showmanship is white top with collar and green bottom.

DOG SHOW- CLASS 23

Superintendent- Ruth Phillips

- **Dogs must be on leash at all times except in classes requiring off leash work.**
- **Classes may be divided or combined depending on entries.**
- **-All dogs must be entered in obedience class and showmanship.**
- **Awards: Blue 8 pts. Red 4 pts. (New London County 4-H'ers)**
- **Juniors are age 7-11 Seniors are age 12-19**
- **All families are encouraged to bring a pop-up tent, as the show ring is in sun and it gets very hot.**

Lots:

1. SHOWMANSHIP

- a. Novice – Handler in 1st or 2nd year of showing
Junior Senior
- b. Intermediate – Handler in 3rd or 4th year of showing
Junior Senior
- c. Advanced – Handler with 5 or more years' experience
Junior Senior

2. OBEDIENCE

- A. **Sub-Novice A**– For first year, inexperienced exhibitors who have not previously trained a dog. Dogs in this class must not have training beyond sub-novice level.
Junior Senior
- B. **Beginner Novice**- For dogs who have not had a qualifying score in Novice.
Junior Senior
- C. **Preferred Novice**- For dogs who have not received a qualifying score in novice or more advanced levels.
- D. **Novice**– Dogs that have finished their CD or its equivalent, or dogs not having a qualifying score in a more advanced level are eligible for this class.
- E. **Graduate Novice**– For dogs that have not received a

qualifying score in Open or Utility. Dogs may have received a CD or its equivalent.

3. WRITTEN TEST

Questions are based on the AKC books Dog Care and Training and The Complete Dog and on the 'Big E' 4-H Rules and Regulations. Emphasis this year is on the Non-Sporting group.

4. **Canine Good Citizen/Community Canine**– Community Canine is for dogs who have already qualified for CGC.

Championships:

- A. **Junior Showmanship Senior Showmanship**
- B. **Junior Obedience Senior Obedience**
- C. **Overall**– will be awarded based on scores in showmanship classes, obedience classes, and written test combined.
- D. **Note: the representative to the Premier Showman contest must be a New London County 4-H'er. In the event that the senior showman champion is from another county, the next highest placing New London County 4-H'er will be the Premier Showman representative.**
