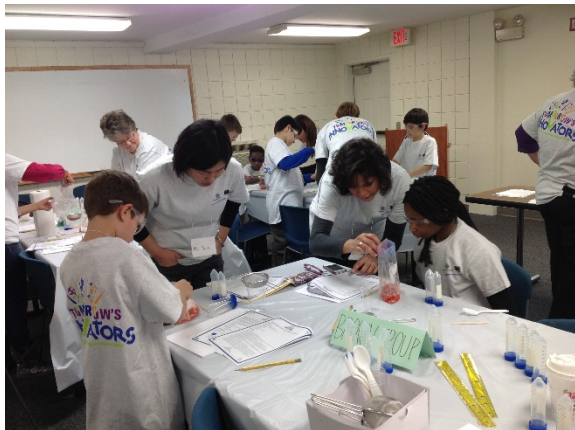
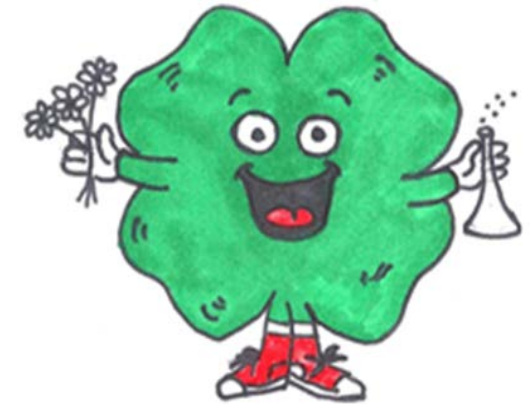

## Connecticut 4-H is looking for YOUTH!!

The UConn 4-H program is offering a fun, science based activity program to youth ages 7- 12!

Discover Science Through 4-H is a free, at-home activity program for youth that would like to join 4-H, but have limited transportation, time or like a smaller group setting.

Each month, Cris Clover, the 4-H mascot, will send an email letter with that month's topic and related science activities ranging from animals, engines and the environment.

While exploring these topics at home working with a supportive adult, youth will also learn more about life skills such as finances, handling emergencies, and environmental stewardship.



Upon signing up for Discover Science Through 4-H, youth will become full-fledged 4-H member in the county they live in. They will start to hear from Cris Clover about what is coming next!

A small sample of topics include:

- Geology
- Sewing and Textiles
- Embryology (Chicks)
- Hippology (Horses)
- Conservation and the Environment
- Small engines
- Photography

And many more!

As well as the emailed activities that can be done at home with family or a friend, Discover Science Through 4-H members will learn about upcoming local, county or state activities which might be of interest. These activities will give them opportunities to get more involved in topics and socialize with others!
