Do you like science? What to have fun? Become a *Discover Science Through 4-H* member. The *Discover Science Through 4-H* is a free, at-home activity program for 7 to 12 year-olds who have little time, no transportation, or who don't like group activities. These youths become full-fledged 4-H members when they sign up for *Discover Science Through 4-H*.

Each month, Cris Clover, the *Discover Science Through 4-H* mascot will send an email letter containing science-related activities such as making bird feeders and tote bags, growing vegetables in the kitchen, creating dish gardens, and caring for pets. Projects also focus on handling emergencies, making nutritious foods, being artistic, and saving energy and the environment. Materials for the projects are easily found in or around their homes. Do them by yourself or with an adult.

Registered participants will also get notices of other 4-H activities being conducted and are encouraged to participate with other youth in these activities.
